# **MEXICO HIGH SCHOOL COMMUNITY SERVICE REQUIREMENT**

The Board of Education of Mexico Academy & Central Schools believes that community service is a vital component in helping students to become responsible citizens.

Students who start 9<sup>th</sup> grade at Mexico High School must complete a minimum of 20 hours of Community Service as a graduation prerequisite. (This requirement will be prorated for students who enter high school after 9<sup>th</sup> grade.)

## **Definition of Community Service:**

Community Service is time and effort that is done without payment of money, grades, and/or services.

#### **Community Service:**

- Provides students with the opportunity to share their talent and abilities with others
- Fosters a partnership between the school and the community
- Helps students understand their responsibilities as members of the community
- Improves self esteem
- Cultivates the development of a sense of compassion
- Engages students in real life experiences

#### Procedure:

Students may begin to earn Community Service hours at the beginning of the year they enter Mexico High School. Students should receive **prior authorization** before performing Community Service, if the student is unsure if the organization qualifies as community service. All hours must be submitted for approval on the proper form and must have all necessary signatures. The high school administration or designee will give final approval of Community Service hours.

Community Service hours will be tallied by the high school administration each year and will be posted outside the Assistant Principals office. The high school administration will notify seniors accumulated hours periodically throughout the year. ## Community Service cannot be done for:

- Family or relatives
- Neighbors
- An employer
- Private Business, any for profit organization
- School or ancillary organizations where belonging to the organization requires the donation of time, effort and/or service.

#### Community Service must be done for a:

- Non-profit organization
- Governmental or Educational Program
- Religious organization if nonproselytizing in nature (non missionary)
