☆Interactive Video and Online College Courses☆

To maximize schedules, students should consider taking all courses in a pathway for the full year.

For example, all courses in the Criminal Justice pathway each day for the FALL and SPRING semester will result in 12 college credits. If a student does not wish to enroll in one of the pathway interactive video course, the student may choose to enroll in an online course opposite the interactive video course. Intersession and Summer Courses are optional and could result in 18 college credits in one year. Additional online courses are available for students with study halls. Students are limited to one additional online course per semester.

*Pathway includes 4 visits throughout the year during the school day to CCC Fulton to complete manufacturing lab hours. Transportation will be provided by the school district. Interactive Video Courses are taken at the school district in a state of the art distance learning room with a distance learning facilitator present. Each college has a matching distance learning room where the professor is located. All courses are instructed by college professors located at Cayuga and Onondaga Community College. Students take courses with other high school students from across Oswego County. Online courses are offered through Cayuga Community College and can be taken during a study hall but must report to the distance learning facilitator located in the school district. All students are progress monitored by CiTi BOCES.
