
Come to Mrs. Kennedy's class to see her students showcasing their Water Cycle and Ancient China projects. We have 3D models, posers, and pamphlets to share!

AVID 7/8: will feature our Innovation Summit winners and their products and awards. We will also showcase student organizational systems, AVID protocols for sucess, and student testimonials.


TECHNOLOGY


Mr. Connolly's Tech 8 and Exploratory Occ classes will be featuring student work on display.

These projects are all student Designed, Manufactured, Assembled and Sold, with proceeds going to support the annual 7th grade field trip to Boldt Castle!






The Physical Education Staff will be outside of the Gymnasium with information on next year's sports.
