



MMS Main Entrance doors open for students at 7:25am for breakfast. Both the Main Entrance and Lower Loop doors will open at 7:30am to allow students into the building and will be locked at 7:35 (or after the drop off line ends). Late students will need to be dropped off at the Main entrance and may sign themselves in at the Main Office. They do not require an adult to sign them in.

When dropping off students, please remember to not pass any bus with flashing lights. The lower loop (by the bus garage) is for students in 5th and 6th grades or larger families while the upper loop (off of Fravor Road) is for 7th and 8th graders only. Please be vigilant watching for students while your vehicle is in motion and follow directions from building staff at both loops.

Dismissal is at 1:56pm. Students who are normally picked up at this time will meet their parents at the appropriate loop for pickup. If you need your student earlier than 1:56, you will need to come into the Main Office to sign your student out. Please follow the directives from our building staff to keep all students safe during dismissal.

We respectfully ask that no parents stop or park in the bus loop in front of the Main Office10 minutes prior to doors opening/dismissal- or while busses are in the loop.


Registering for ParentSquare from the App

ParentSquare makes it easy to register for ParentSquare from the app. Simply download the app on your Apple or Android device and follow the steps below:

- 1. Open the ParentSquare App.
- 2. Enter your email or cell phone number.

Note: Please be sure to register with the same email that you have used for SchoolTool's Parent Porital Access. If your email is not recognized by ParentSquare, you can "Request Access" or call your school office and ask them to update your contact information.
