If you have recently observed a Bluebird, you can thank the campaign to save the Eastern Bluebird. After extensive research, students found out that several decades ago, wildlife experts started to notice a sharp decline in the Bluebird population. This drop in population was the result of two main factors. The first being the introduction to the House Sparrow(invasive species) and deforestation(loss of habitat).

Students researched the potential design specifications and considerations to build a proper Bluebird house. Their final design was then verified via a Zoom call with Dr. Allison Hazel, DVM, a wildlife expert currently residing in Golden Colorado. Dr. Hazel graciously met with each of the 4 Technology Education classes to discuss ideas and to help answer existing questions regarding the life of the Eastern Bluebird.

Students plan to build approximately 100 birdhouses to sell over the next few weeks. Quantities are limited and we will start the presale of tickets today. Each birdhouse is \$20. Funds generated from this activity will help support an upcoming field trip to the St. Lawrence River and Boldt castle as part of their Marine Navigation unit starting soon.
