I've been volunteering there this fall and it's a lot of fun and easy work! They don't have many dogs, usually 4-6 at a time, and shifts are only 90 minutes. 3-4 people work at a shift, and they are 6:30 am/1 pm/6:30 pm M-F, and on weekends we do 7 am/1pm/7 pm. Volunteers have to be at least 18 yrs old due to insurance, so if there are seniors looking to get some hours in and help a great cause, PAOC would love the help. Folks can sign up for as many shifts as they want each week, there's no minimum requirement. There are also opportunities to help with fundraising events if that interests anyone.
